Introduction

The MAISHA certification reporting system was developed following the revision of HIV and AIDS Strategic Framework (KASF) 2014/2015 – 2018/19 to ensure full compliance by the Ministries, Counties, Departments and Agencies (MCDA) in reporting and help the public sector achieve performance contract requirements. Based on third quarter scorecard recommendations that arose from challenges facing the quarterly reporting, National AIDS Control Council organized a capacity building workshop that targeted MDA’s where a total of 281 MDA’s were trained and sensitized on the Maisha Certification System. Among the challenges faced was inconsistent reporting, late reporting and use of wrong reporting templates.

Reporting Timelines

During the reporting period it was noted that most of the institutions that reported (96%) used the correct reporting template as compared to the 2nd quarter where less than half (41%) of those who reported used the right tool. It was also noted that out of 315 MDA’s, 185 MDA’s had reported as at August 1, 2016 and 161 of those who had reported, reported on time using the right template.

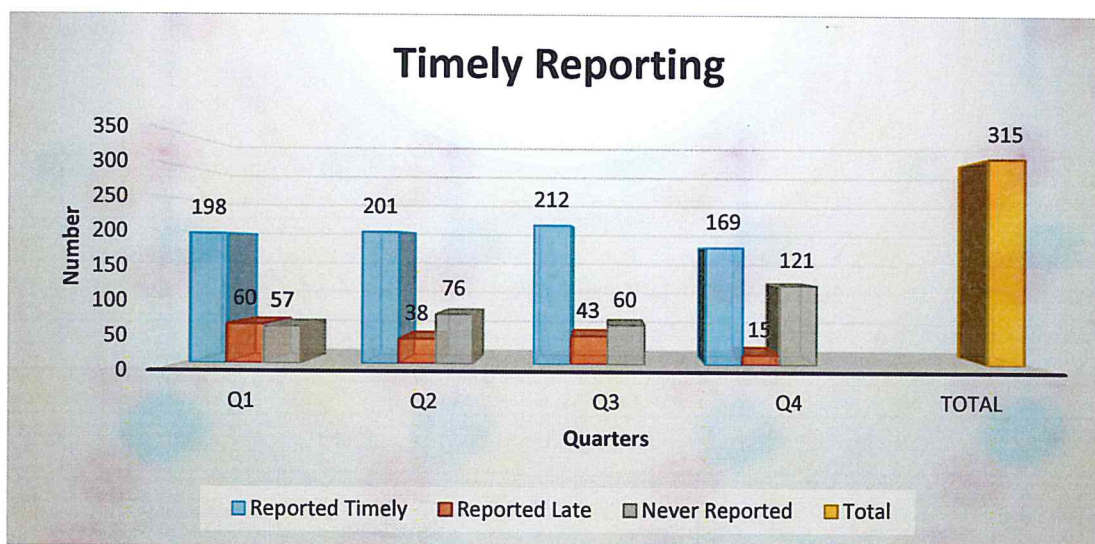


Figure 1: Number of MDA’s that reported in time FY 2015/16

The deadline for submitting quarter 4 reports was June 15, 2016 and any institution reporting after the 15th was considered to have reported late. Figure 1 above illustrates reporting trends for the public sector for the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th quarter. Out of 315 MDA’s and 47 county governments, in quarter one: 198 (62.9%) reported on time, 60 (19%) late and 57 (18.1%) had not reported by the

time this report was being compiled. In quarter two: 201 (63.8%) reported on time, 38 (12.1%) reported late and 76 (24.1%) had not reported by the time this report was being compiled. In quarter three: 212 (67.3%) reported on time, 43 (13.7%) reported late and 60 (19%) had not reported by the time this report was being compiled. Finally, in quarter four: 179 (56.8%) reported on time, 15 (4.8%) reported late and a large number of 121 (38.4%) had not reported by the time this report was being compiled.

Report Card for Quarter 4 FY 2015/2016

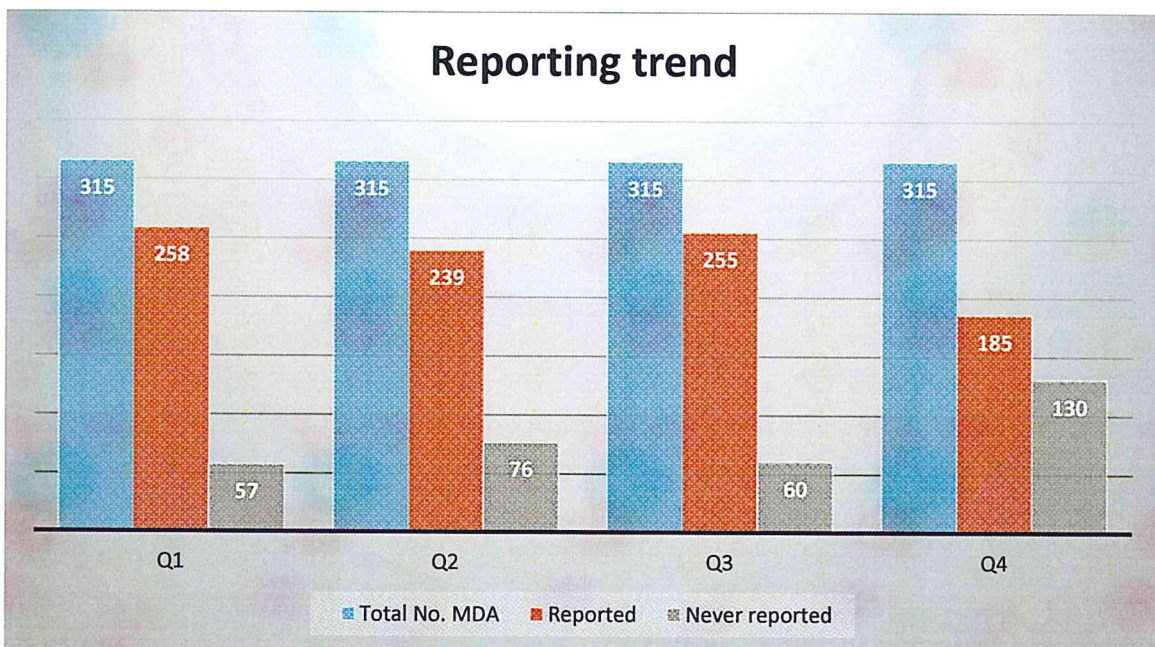


Figure 2: Reporting Trends

Figure 2 below illustrates reporting trends for the public sector for the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th quarter. Out of 315 MDA's and 47 county governments 258 (81.9%) reported in quarter one, 239 (75.8%) reported in quarter 2, 255 (80.9%) reported in quarter 3 and 185 (58.7 %) reported in quarter 4 of the financial year 2015/2016. Kakamega County Government remains the only county in compliance with the Maisha certification process. Inconsistent and late reporting is identified as the main challenge in the MAISHA certification process.

The 13th Performance Contract Cycle indicators on Prevention of new HIV infections

During the 13th PC cycle MDA's in MAISHA 1 are expected to:

- Allocate a budget for the HIV activities/programmes to be implemented
- Establish/ reconstitute and operationalise HIV & AIDS Control Unit with 40% of the membership drawn from the senior and middle levels. A senior officer will chair the Committee.
- Conduct a baseline survey on staff knowledge level on HIV and AIDS.
- Develop a work place policy on HIV and AIDS.
- Report on at least four HIV interventions every quarter selected from the MAISHA 1 reporting template
- Submit quarterly reports to NACC using MAISHA 1 reporting template

Those that have completed MAISHA 1 and have been allowed to proceed to MAISHA 2 will be expected to utilize their competencies to reach their clients and other stakeholders with activities that mitigate against HIV and AIDS Infections. To achieve this, MDA's will be required to:

- Identify and implement 2 interventions from the public sector HIV plans
- Allocate Resources for the HIV activities/programmes
- Continue implementing MAISHA 1 activities
- Carry out at least two (2) recommendations from the baseline survey conducted in MAISHA 1 on Comprehensive Staff Knowledge of HIV & AIDS

In the financial year 2016/17 Counties too will be expected to comply with the Maisha Certification Process by carrying out the following activities:

- Operationalise Monitoring and Evaluation for the CASP in line with one M&E framework
- Allocate Resources for the HIV activities/programmes
- Implement activities identified within the CASP
- Conduct a baseline survey on county staff knowledge level on HIV and AIDS.

Reporting on MAISHA 1 Requirements

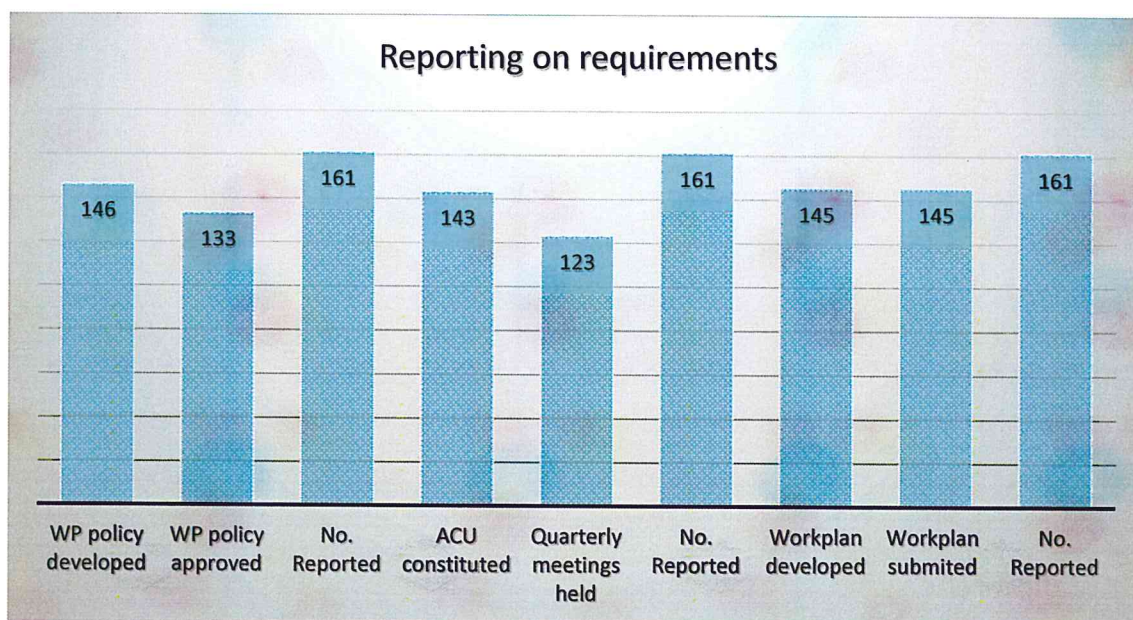


Figure 3 reporting on requirements

The workplace policy, AIDS Control Unit and a work plan are requirements that MCDA's are expected to have in place to help facilitate their reporting as aligned to the Kenya AIDS Strategic Framework (KASF). According to figure 3, out of the 161 Institutions that reported using the correct reporting template;

- 146 (90.7%) reported to have developed a workplace policy with 82.6% (133) having been approved
- 143 (88.8%) reported, to have an AIDS Control Unit that were formerly constituted however only 123 (76.4%) held meetings each quarter as required.
- In addition, 145 (90.1%) of the Institutions reported to have developed a work plan with clear targets and submitted to NACC.

However, a relatively low percentage of Institutions did not give a response on whether they had a workplace policy and ACU in place or whether they had developed a work plan with clear targets and submitted to NACC.

Reporting Trends

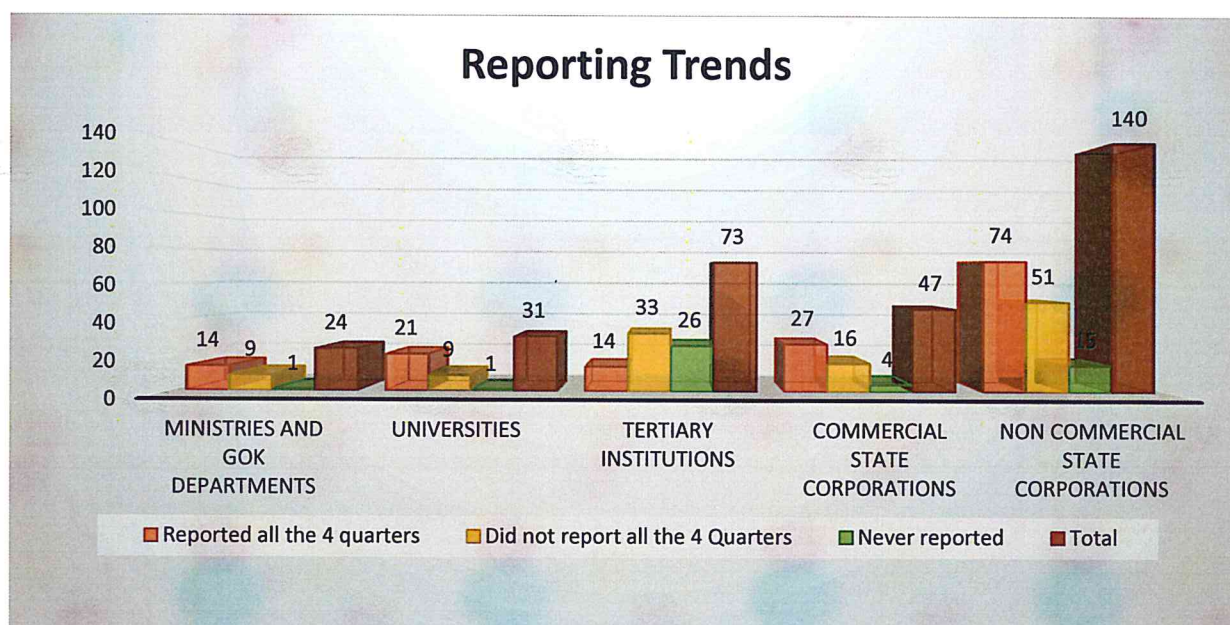


Figure 4 reporting rates among public sector institutions

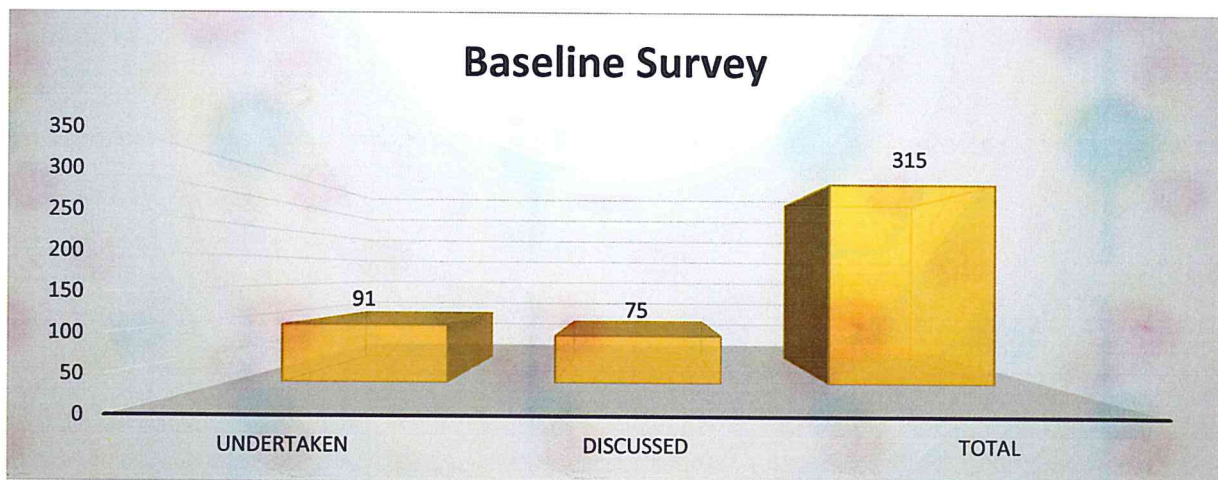


Figure 4: Showing the Baseline Survey Reporting

According to figure 4 below, Universities (96.8%) have the highest reporting rate followed by Ministries and GOK's at (95.8%), Commercial State Corporations at (91.5%), Non Commercial State Corporations at 89.3% and the least reporting rate was among Tertiary Institutions at (64.4%). Kakamega County was the only county that reported consistently through the financial year 2015/2016, however, all counties are expected to embrace the MAISHA reporting system in the financial year 2016/2017.

Public Sector Contribution to the National HIV Response

During the 4th quarter reporting period, approximately *Ksh.* 70,323,658 was allocated for HIV and AIDS activities. As a result MDA's were able to reach 16,504 employees with counseling and testing services, 39,450 with comprehensive knowledge on HIV and AIDS prevention and 17,067 with ART treatment literacy. In addition MDA's distributed 1,029,547 condoms and sensitized 39,510 staff on reducing stigma and discrimination towards PLHIV.

According to the 4th quarter MAISHA score card 4,366 staff and family members reported uptake of services that include PEP, VCT, VMMC, PMTCT and ART. Additionally, out of the 161 organizations that reported in quarter four, 65 reported to have put in place workplace benefits, such as health insurance, and food baskets catering for PLHIV.

In the financial year 2015/16 approximately (28.9%) of those who adhered to the 12 PC cycle reporting requirements reported having conducted a baseline survey on HIV Knowledge and Attitudes among their staff and submitted the baseline survey report to National AIDS Control Council. However, only (82.4%) of those who conducted and submitted the baseline survey have discussed and developed recommendations. Almost all Institutions (98.8%) who reported in the 4th quarter reported having submitted their quarterly reports to NACC in line with PC requirements by the 15th day after the end of the quarter.
